Location of Upcoming Events

All rehearsals/techs as well as the Spotlight Performance will be held in the Mt. Zion Theatre.

Parent Volunteer Needs & Policies (includes arrival time)

Volunteers are needed in the following areas: ushers, backstage/green room, dressing rooms, set-up and clean-up. If you have a ticket, volunteers that will be released in time to see the show include: ushers, set-up and clean-up. Arrival time for volunteers is 4:30pm (4:15pm for Dance Company members that are working) on both Tuesday and Thursday. Assistance is required on both Tuesday and Thursday from 12pm to 2:30pm for set-up.

Tickets & Performance Participation

Only the Company classes and our Starting Up students will be performing in this year's spotlight.

We are excited once again to have the Starting Up classes be a part of our show (please refer to the show order for details on when each class/routine is performing). We rely on volunteer support for our show to run smoothly. We would love for you to sign up to assist at dress rehearsal and at least one show. We appreciate your support during this very busy season. As always, you will be able to see the company routines perform again at the In House Competition and at the May recital.

Tickets will be sold at \$5 each (additional donations are welcome). Tickets will be available for purchase beginning Monday, November 27, 2017 at 5pm. Tickets will be available at the front desk Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 5pm to 8pm. All tickets must be purchased in person at the desk during the designated hours.

Due to limited seating in the Theatre, each **family** will be allowed to pick up 4 tickets for each show in which their child is performing (see show order for details). Allocated tickets will be held until Thursday, Dec 7th for each family. For those of you that would like additional tickets, these may be picked up beginning Monday, December 11th. Seats for the Spotlight are not assigned. There is not a 'bad' seat in the house. As such, to be fair to everyone, saving seats prior to doors being opened is not permitted.

Your account must be in good standing in order to purchase tickets and for your child(ren) to be eligible to participate in the Mid-Year Spotlight.

Check-In/Backstage/Dressing Room/Green Room Policies

Restricted areas will include the green room, dressing rooms, backstage, & the ticket area.

Check-in for the Spotlight will take place just outside the Green Room. You will be given your designated area at that time. All students will either be assigned to a dressing room, an area in the Green Room or backstage.

Please no food or gum in the theatre/auditorium. There will be a limited amount of time between the rehearsal and when the performance begins so if at all possible, please try and eat dinner before you arrive for rehearsal. Otherwise, water, dry snacks, and/or a dry sack lunch/dinner such as a sandwich and apple are permitted in the dressing rooms/backstage/theatre but we encourage all students to eat a healthy meal prior to their arrival/performance. Colored beverages, sugary sodas, fast food meals, pizzas, or anything else that might stain are absolutely **NOT** permitted in dressing rooms/theatre. We **DO** have students that have airborne allergies to peanuts. As such, absolutely **NO** foods that might contain nuts.

Student Policies

Students are expected to arrive on time for the both the rehearsals & performances. Please do not chew gum on the premises.

Please give the highest respect to all adults, teachers & volunteers working to make this performance a great experience for you.

Students must stay in their assigned dressing room area for both the dress rehearsal & final performance. Please, no students in the theatre or lobby at any time.

Please label all items and carry all bags/boxes with student's first & last name. Starting up students should only bring a

small bag with their shoes, items needed for the finale, and a bottle of water.

Section C • Rehearsal and Performance Information

Dress Rehearsal

Arrival time is 4:30pm sharp. EVERYONE must arrive in costume (t-shirts will be provided at check-in), with hair done. Rehearsal will take place on Tuesday and Thursday, respectively before each show.

We have a limited amount of time to run our show and this is the first time the students will have an opportunity to perform on the theatre stage. As such, the Dress Rehearsal is closed to all parents, siblings, and visitors. Family members/guests can remain in the café or may leave and return for the performance taking place that same evening.

Performance Info

Each performance will take place immediately following the rehearsal. There will be a limited amount of time between the rehearsal and when the performance begins so if at all possible, please try and eat dinner before you arrive for rehearsal (if not, please pack a small snack accordingly – no nuts due to airborne allergies among our students). The performance will begin at 6:30pm each evening and is estimated to be just over an hour long.

Costumes/Hair/Make-up

All students will be provided a shirt (to be worn for the duration of the performance) at the dress rehearsal check-in. ALL girls are to wear a black leotard under their outfit due to possible quick changes backstage. Please label ALL items with your name. Your account must be in good standing in order to receive/pick-up your T-shirt.

Company Students – only bring **small** bag with shoes, finale items, snack and a water

- Attire (including shoes):
 - ✓ Hip Hop Routines – Black sweats (no markings; can be worn inside out if necessary) or black company pants with high tops (any type)
 - ✓ Jazz Routines – Black ankle leggings with black jazz shoes and black skirts.
 - ✓ Contemporary Routines – Black ankle leggings, red shirt tied around the waist, and bare feet.
- Hair: low, right side bun.
- Make-up (girls only): full stage make-up (blue/brown eye shadow, red lips, pink cheeks, eyeliner and mascara)

Starting Up Students (ages 3 thru 6) – only bring **small** bag with shoes, finale items, snack and a water

- Attire (including shoes):
 - ✓ Girls – all girls should wear a black leotard with black full leggings.
 - Girls in Hip Hop need tennis shoes (any type).
 - Girls in Ballet need pink ballet shoes.
 - Girls in Tap need black tap shoes.
 - ✓ Boys – all boys should wear black pants.
 - Boys in Hip Hop will need tennis shoes.
 - Boys in Ballet will perform in bare feet.
 - Boys in Tap need black tap shoes.
- Hair (girls only): a bun on the crown of their head.
- Make-up (girls only): full stage make-up (any color eye shadow, red/pink lips, pink cheeks)

Finale Information

All dancers will participate in the finale dance. Finale dress will include the Spotlight t-shirt ordered by the School, black pants along with any type of “Elf” accessory to wear (scarf, hat, gloves, etc...).
