# PAYMENT

## Program Content

The program is an ALL INCLUSIVE program that begins in June 2019 and culminates in June 2020. Once enrolled in the Kidz Theatre program, tuition is non-refundable and full (entire year) payment is expected. Students are expected to complete the program in its entirety.

## Pricing and Payment Terms:

The cost is: \$429 tuition, \$50 commitment fee, \$10 class fee, and costume fee

- June 28, 2019: \$143 tuition, \$50 commitment fee plus \$10 class fee
- November 4, 2019: \$143 plus \$30 costume deposit
- February 3, 2020: \$143 plus balance of the costume fee

Please note that your account must be in good standing in order to participate in each event, receive your costume/t-shirt, and purchase tickets in May. A late fee of 5% will be applied.

## Price includes:

- Specialized training focused on dance and vocals during September.
- Two performances.
- One costume and one t-shirt as part of the costume fee.
- One copy of instruction and corresponding materials such as scripts, props and music CDs. A fee will be assessed for additional copies.

## Refund and Cancellation Policies:

Each participant is critical to the success of this program and once registered, your team/classmates are depending on you. As such, if you choose to remove your child from the program once registered, refunds will not be given and all fees will be due for the Kidz Theatre program as follows:

- Full tuition/class fee of \$439 plus the \$50 commitment fee is expected from all participants once registered for Kidz Theatre in June.
- Costume deposit is non-refundable on or after November 4, 2019. Full costume is non-refundable on or after February 3, 2020.

## Code of Conduct/Other Policies and Procedures:

All policies and decisions are at the sole discretion of the Mt. Zion School of Performing Arts. We reserve the right to expel any student based on behavior, attitude, attendance, or other issues. Refunds will not be given in these circumstances.

# GENERAL INFO

## Parent Expectations

- A meeting will be held for parents regarding the Kidz Theatre program on Monday, June 24, 2019 at 6pm in the Mt. Zion Theatre to answer any last minute questions you may have. Signed registration and contracts will be due at this meeting.
- The Kidz Theatre program is a comprehensive program which includes the Intensives as well as performances in June. Participation is mandatory in these events.
- Unexcused absences from Run Thrus and Tech Rehearsals will prevent a student from performing in the show.
- Multiple performances are being held. Parents are expected to volunteer at one of the two performances.
- Parents are invited to attend the performances. Auditions and rehearsals are restricted to students and teachers only.
- If your student runs into a problem with a teacher or another student, please approach the teacher first to discuss the situation. If you still feel the issue has not been resolved, please contact the theatre director.

## Student Expectations

- The program commitment begins in June even though the first class is in September and runs through the following June.
- Student attendance is mandatory at intensives, rehearsals, techs, and performances. Unexcused absences from Run Thrus and Tech Rehearsals will prevent a student from performing in the show.
- Each Kidz Theatre student is allowed 4 excused absences. If the allowed number of excused absences is exceeded, it will influence participation in the final performance.
- Your attendance and behavior may influence casting and your ability to participate in the performances at the Director's discretion.
- All students should arrive 10 minutes prior to class.
- Costumes and accessories are the property of the student.
- Proper attire is required to participate in class: modest, comfortable clothing and shoes that allows each student to move, bend, and sit on the floor. Please no dresses, skirts or skorts.
- Each student will need their own theatre make-up kit.
- The use of cell phones is prohibited during class, rehearsals and performances.

## Commitment Fee Required for All Students

- The first payment of \$203 is due on June 28, 2019.
- If all program requirements are met, \$50 will be refunded in June 2020. Program requirements include but are not limited to: attendance at all events (rehearsals, run thrus, techs, and performances), enrollment and completion of the appropriate School of Performing Arts technique classes (limited to 5 absences), as well as parent volunteer expectations.
- If a student leaves the program or drops their Performing Arts class prior to June 1, 2020, for any reason, refunds will not be given. Full tuition/class fee of \$439 plus the \$50 commitment deposit will be due. Costume refunds will be given based on the schedule in the Refund and Cancellation schedule of this brochure.

## Pre-Requisites for Participation

- All students must attend the Intensives (included in tuition price).
- All students must be enrolled in at least one School of Performing Arts theatre/broadway class for an additional fee.
- Registration forms for the required technique class must be submitted to the School of Performing Arts no later than Friday, July 26, 2019.
